New Mexico Technology Assistance

Program (NMTAP) provides assistive technology related assistance for individuals with disabilities of any age, any disability, any income who are living anywhere in NM. Our program is designed to meet the requirements of the AT Act of 2004, part of US public law.

What is Assistive Technology? Assistive Technology (AT) includes any device or system that is used to increase, maintain or improve functional capabilities of an individual with a disability in education, employment and community engagement.

SERVICES PROVIDED:

Device Loan Program:

Our Device Loan Program provides short-term loans of AT devices for any individual with a disability. Devices can be borrowed to try out before purchasing, to act as a loaner until a personal device is repaired, to provide training or for short-term accommodations.

Device Demonstration:

We arrange device demonstrations for individuals or groups which are designed to explore and compare similar types of AT that are available to provide access for those with cognitive, visual, speech, hearing and mobility issues. This helps individuals and/or professionals make an informed decision on what works best.

Information and Assistance: We also provide information on AT devices and AT services. This includes information on availability of resources and funding through public and private sources to obtain devices or services. This also includes referrals to other agencies, organizations or companies. We support AT use in life transitions, including successful transition into higher education.

Training: We offer instructional events for groups designed to increase knowledge, skills and competencies regarding AT. Limited individual training is also offered.

Device Reutilization: NMTAP can provide used AT to individuals with disabilities when there are no other options. Adelante Development Center is our partner who provides this assistance. Request or donate an item through our website or call the numbers below.
